Privacy Statement 2020 Contributions to the administrative expenditures of the SRB

Regulation (EU) 2018/1725¹ (herein after "**the Regulation**") applies to the processing of personal data of representatives of institutions in the context of Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2017/2361². - The <u>purpose of the processing</u> is to contact, where necessary, directly the representatives of the institutions, which assist the SRB in collection of the administrative contributions to the administrative expenditures of the SRB (herein after **the "Process"**).
- The only <u>category of data collected</u> (provided to the SRB by the ECB in accordance with article 6 of DR (EU) 2017/2361 and/or by institutions directly) and used for the Process are contact details of person(s) designated by the institutions.
- The <u>recipients of the data</u> collected are the staff members of the Units E2 and E4 of the SRB and/or any other person designated by the SRB to assist the Unit E4 Contributions & Financing in processing the operations, *including but not limited* to employees of external consultants.
- Your rights with respect to your data: You have the right to request from the Units E2 and E4 access to and rectification or erasure of personal data or restriction of processing concerning your data or, where applicable, the right to object to processing or the right to data portability; for this purpose, please contact SRB-ADMIN-CONTRIBUTIONS@srb.europa.eu. The right of rectification can only apply to factual data processed.
- The legal basis of the Process is Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2017/2361.
- The time limit for storing the data is maximum one year following the moment the controller receives the confirmation that you are no longer involved in the Process.
