Purpose of the tender:

Purpose of the launch of this negotiated procedure is the signature of a contract as soon as possible with one economic operator for a duration of 9 months.

The SRB had a fire incident related to the photovoltaic panels on its building at Treurenberg 22 in Brussels recently and is looking for a company who provides the following two experts:

 Expert on Building Safety who evaluates the structural and functional integrity of the SRB building following a recent fire incident, with a focus on assessing damage to the façade and roof.

Minimum requirements:

- Degree in Civil/Structural Engineering, Architecture, or equivalent.
- 3+ years in structural assessments and fire-damage evaluations.
- Proven expertise with façades, roofs, photovoltaic panels.
- Experience in designing repairs and reinforcements for fire-damaged buildings.
- Familiarity with fire-resistant materials.
- Expert in Fire Protection who analyses and enhances fire safety protocols, with an emphasis
 on investigating the recent fire incident (Fire Protection).

Minimum requirements:

- Degree in Civil/Structural Engineering, Architecture, or a related field.
- 3+ years of experience in fire safety assessments and incident investigations.
- Expertise in root cause analysis of fire incidents, including electrical systems and photovoltaic panels.
- Knowledge of fire safety standards and codes.
- Proficiency in evaluating and designing improvements for fire alarms, sensors, and suppression systems

Further information will be provided in the invitation to tender and the technical specifications that detail the minimum requirements of the profiles that are needed.

Background information



The Single Resolution Board (hereinafter referred to as the SRB) is a key element of the Banking Union and its 'Single Resolution Mechanism' (SRM). This mechanism complements the 'Single Supervisory Mechanism' (SSM) which, since November 2014, sees the European Central Bank directly supervise banks in the euro area and in other countries which decide to join the Banking Union.

The SRB is the European resolution authority for the Banking Union and based on the Regulation (EU) No. 806/20141 (hereinafter referred to SRM-Regulation or ('SRMR') an independent EU agency. It has been set up at the beginning of 2015 and has built up its internal resources and is fully operational since January 1, 2016.

Description of the procedure:

This Ex-ante publicity is the first stage of a negotiated procurement procedure below the Directive threshold with minimum 3 candidates, through which the Agency may award the abovementioned contract.

The aim of this notice is to support the SRB in the selection of the tenderers who will be invited to submit a tender for the contract, in order to provide the catering services described above.

Economic operators interested in taking part in this tender should send an e-mail expressing their interest by 16/12/2024 12:00 Brussels time to SRB-PROCUREMENT@srb.europa.eu. Further specific information (Invitation to tender, technical specifications and deadline to submit the offer) will be communicated to all interested economic operators.

It should be noted that the SRB reserves the right not to launch the negotiated procedure. This decision shall be communicated accordingly.
